




Lindura® – The wood flooring revolution

Sustainable. Robust. Practical. That is Lindura wood flooring. And this is precisely what makes this flooring the wood flooring of the future. Manufacturing its surfaces uses approximately one eighth of the wood that is used for conventional multi-layered parquet flooring. How does it work? With an innovative manufacturing process! So-called wood powder technology makes the resource-efficient, real wood covering layer extremely resistant to dents. Wood powder is a fine mix of materials consisting of wood fibres, mineral substances and other additives. It is firmly pressed together with the real wood surface, forming a stable connection that ensures incredibly practical wood flooring!





8 times less wood

Thanks to its special product structure, the Lindura wood flooring surfaces only require about an eighth of the amount of wood compared to conventional multi-layer parquet flooring.





Wood from sustainable forestry

For Lindura, we exclusively use PEFC-certified wood.

Energy-saving

Even with floating installations on a hot water underfloor heating system, Lindura boasts very low thermal resistance (0.084 m²K/W; in conjunction with the MEISTER-Silence 25 dB insulating underlay). This means that the flooring does not insulate the warmth; instead, the warmth is released quickly and with minimal loss into the room.






Water-resistant






Robust

The Lindura surface is antibacterial and is suited to both living spaces subject to heavy wear and commercial spaces (e.g. shops and hotel rooms). The ultra matt lacquered variant in particular offers permanent protection against normal household stains and micro-scratches with little maintenance required*.


* Micro-scratches are small scratches on the lacquered surface that do not penetrate through to the real wood layer.

Two things give MEISTER floors their amazingly long life: the high quality, carefully selected materials and the intelligent multi-layer structure. Together with the dimensionally stable HDF middle layer used by us, this guarantees you a tough floor that remains beautiful over many years. The Weartec*Nature and Duratec Nature surface finishes emphasise the character of the respective woods using high quality oils, waxes or varnish and ensure durable, easy to maintain floors. Lindura wood flooring is also suitable for laying on subfloors with controlled hot water underfloor heating hot water underfloor heating with cooling function.

Knots, cracks and the like: How the grading shapes the flooring aesthetics

In nature, no one tree is like another – even within one tree, the wood looks very different. This is also the case with wood flooring: each individual plank is shaped by structure, the number of knotholes and cracks, and the colours at play in the wood that's being processed. The so-called grading describes where wood flooring will appear more calm and elegant or varied and rustic. With Lindura wood flooring, we differentiate between four gradings. Incidentally, thanks to the wood powder technology, even the smallest knotholes and cracks are filled in Lindura surfaces, unlike with parquet flooring.

The complete system counts: Underlay for high-quality flooring

Without a good underlay, it's not a good floor: the underlay material has a significant influence on the durability of the flooring and is an important component of how the entire system functions as far as day-to-day wear is concerned. Premium-quality flooring may suffer damage when laid on poor-quality underlay. High quality underlay ensures long enjoyment of your flooring – by preventing damage to the click connections with ideal pressure stability, for example – excessively soft underlay can have a significantly negative effect on fold-down connections. When choosing an underlay material, both the sub-flooring and the flooring to be installed are important. Whether your sub-flooring is concrete, wooden floorboards, prefabricated screed or existing flooring such as tiles or stone, with a comprehensive underlay range, MEISTER ensures that every MEISTER floor can be laid on your sub-flooring.




